THE MINISTERIAL ENQUIRY INTO THE EVICTION OF THE INFORMAL SETTLEMENT COMMUNITY OF NOMZAMO (LWANDLE), CAPE TOWN.

The Commission of Enquiry into the eviction of the informal settlement community of Nomzamo (Lwandle) hereby invites members of the public to make submissions and written comments.

The Enquiry seeks to:

- Investigate all the circumstances under which the evictions took place, and the history of the evictions, including the facts leading to the application for and obtaining of the court order on 24 January 2014 by SANRAL; the execution of the said court order by SANRAL; the role of the relevant Sheriff for the jurisdiction of Cape Town; the roles of the law enforcement officials of the South Africa Police Services, the Cape Town Metro Police and any other official of the national, provincial and local government involved and any other person;
- Establish the identity of the members of the informal settlement community of Lwandle, how the community came to be on the land in question when there is waiting list for the provision of housing in terms of government programmes.

- Report to the Minister on its investigation and findings; and
- Make necessary recommendations to the Minister for consideration.
