INITIATION OF A SUNSET REVIEW OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON STAINLESS STEEL SINKS ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (CHINA) AND MALAYSIA

In accordance with the provisions in Article 53.1 of the Anti-Dumping Regulations (ADR), any definitive anti-dumping duty shall be terminated on a date not later than five years from the date of imposition, unless the International Trade Administration Commission (the Commission) determines, in a review initiated before that date on its own initiative or upon a duly substantiated request made by or on behalf of the domestic industry, that the expiry of the duty would likely lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury.

On 28 June 2013, the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (the Commission) notified the interested parties through Notice No. 664 of 2013 in *Government Gazette* No. 36592, that unless a substantiated request is made indicating that the expiry of the anti-dumping duties against imports of stainless steel sinks originating in or imported from China and Malaysia would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury, the anti-dumping duties on stainless steel sinks originating in or imported from China and Malaysia will expire on 5 November 2014.

A response to the sunset review application questionnaire was received from Franke Kitchen Systems (Pty) Ltd on behalf of the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) industry on 13 August 2014.

THE APPLICANT

The application was lodged by Franke Kitchen Systems (Pty) Ltd, the major producer of stainless steel sinks in the SACU. The Applicant is one of two producers of stainless steel sinks in the SACU. A letter of support was received from PABAR (Pty) Ltd, the other producer in the SACU.

The Applicant alleges that the expiry of the duty would likely lead to continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury. The Applicant submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Commission to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that a sunset review investigation should be initiated.

THE PRODUCT

The product allegedly being dumped is stainless steel sinks classifiable under tariff subheading 7324.10 originating in or imported from China and Malaysia.

THE ALLEGATION OF THE CONTINUATION OR RECURRENCE OF DUMPING

The allegation of continuation or recurrence of dumping is based on the comparison between the normal values and the export prices.

The Applicant provided domestic selling prices in China and Malaysia obtained from price lists in the respective countries for purposes of the normal value. To calculate the export price for China, the Applicant provided the average f.o.b import price from the official SARS import statistics for the period 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2013. As there were no imports from Malaysia during the period of investigation, the Applicant provided the official SARS import statistics for 2010, which was then increased by the Malaysian producer price index for the period 2010 to 2013 to obtain the export price for 2013.

On this basis, the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of the likelihood of continuation or recurrence of dumping should the duties expire.

THE ALLEGATION OF CONTINUATION OR RECURRENCE OF MATERIAL INJURY

The Applicant alleges and submitted *prima facie* evidence to show that it is experiencing a decline in profits, production, capacity utilisation, employment and return on investment and that there would be price undercutting, price depression and suppression should the anti-dumping duties expire.

On this basis the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of the continuation or recurrence of material injury should the duties expire.

PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The investigation period for dumping is from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2013 and the injury investigation involves evaluation of data for the period of 01 January 2011 to 31 December 2013. The Commission will also consider an estimate of what the situation would be, should the anti-dumping duties expire.

PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of a sunset review investigation, the Commission has begun an investigation in terms of section 16 of the International Trade Administration Act, 2002 (the ITA Act). The Commission will conduct its investigation in accordance with the relevant sections of the ITA Act and the Anti-Dumping Regulations of the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ADR). Both the ITA Act and the ADR are available on the Commission's website (www.itac.org.za) or from the Trade Remedies section, on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Commission will send non-confidential versions of the application and questionnaires to all known importers and exporters, and known representative associations. The trade representatives of the exporting countries have also been notified.

Importers and other interested parties are invited to contact the Commission as soon as possible in order to determine whether they have been listed and were furnished with the relevant documentation. If not, they should immediately ensure that they are sent copies. The questionnaire has to be completed and any other representations must be made within the time limit set out below.

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Please note that if any information is considered to be confidential then <u>a non-confidential version of the information must be submitted</u> for the public file, simultaneously with the confidential version. In submitting a non-confidential version the following rules are strictly applicable and parties must indicate:

- where confidential information has been omitted and the nature of such information;
- reasons for such confidentiality;
- a summary of the confidential information which permits a reasonable understanding of the substance of the confidential information; and
- in exceptional cases, where information is not susceptible to summary, reasons must be submitted to this effect.

This rule applies to all parties and to all correspondence with and submissions to the Commission, which unless indicated to be confidential and filed together with a non-confidential version, will be placed on the public file and be made available to other interested parties.

If a party considers that any document of another party, on which that party is submitting representations, does not comply with the above rules and that such deficiency affects that party's ability to make meaningful representations, the details of the deficiency and the reasons why that party's rights are so affected must be submitted to the Commission in writing forthwith (and at the latest 14 days prior to the date on which that party's submission is due).

Failure to do so timeously will seriously hamper the proper administration of the investigation, and such party will not be able to subsequently claim an inability to make meaningful representations on the basis of the failure of such other party to meet the requirements.

Subsection 33(1) of the ITA Act provides that any person claiming confidentiality of information should identify whether such information is *confidential by nature* or is *otherwise confidential* and, any such claims must be supported by a written statement, in each case, setting out how the information satisfies the requirements of the claim to confidentiality. In the alternative, a sworn statement should be made setting out reasons why it is impossible to comply with these requirements

Section 2.3 of the ADR provides as follows:

"The following list indicates "information that is by nature confidential" as per section 33(1)(a) of the Main Act, read with section 36 of the Promotion of Access to Information Act (Act 2 of 2000):

- (a) management accounts;

The Senior Manager: Trade Remedies 1, should receive all responses, including non-confidential copies of the responses, not later than 40 days from the date hereof, or 30 days from the date on which the letter accompanying the abovementioned questionnaire was received. The said letter shall be deemed to have been received seven days after the day of its dispatch.

Late submissions will not be accepted except with the prior written consent of the Commission. The Commission will give due consideration to written requests for an extension of not more than 14 days on good cause shown (properly motivated and substantiated), if received prior to the expiry of the original deadline. In September 2013, the Commission introduced a Price Preference System (PPS) pursuant to which it would not allow the exportation of scrap metal unless it had first been offered for sale to the domestic scrap consuming industry with the intention to domestically beneficiate such scrap metal. Under the PPS, exporters are required to offer scrap metal at 20% below the international benchmark price.

The Commission recommended that a review of the applicable preferential rates be conducted one year after the date of its implementation. The review aims to determine a price preference level that is sufficient to assist the metals beneficiation industries.

Interested parties are hereby invited to submit comments on the following proposed amendments to the price preference levels:

- An increase in the price preference rate for steel (including stainless steel) scrap metal from 20% to 30% below the international benchmark price;
- An increase in the price preference rate for aluminium scrap metal from 20% to 25% below the international benchmark price; and
- the existing price preference rate of 20% to remain for all other types of scrap metal.




Figure 1: Integrated Units of Analysis in the Crocodile (West), Marico, Matlabas and Mokolo catchments




FIGURE 1: MAP ILLUSTRATING THE INTEGRATED UNITS OF ANALYSIS FOR THE OLIFANTS CATCHMENT




Figure 1: Integrated Units of Analysis in the Middle Vaal




Figure 1: Integrated Units of Analysis in the Lower Vaal




Figure 1: Integrated Units of Analysis in the Upper Vaal

PROPOSED CLASSES OF WATER RESOURCE FOR THE LETABA CATCHMENT OF IN TERMS OF SECTION 13(1)(A) OF THE NATIONAL WATER ACT, 1998, ACT NO.36 OF 1998

1 DESCRIPTION OF WATER RESOURCE

1. The proposed classes are determined for all or part of every significant water resource within the Letaba catchment as set out below:

Water Management Area: Olifants

Drainage Region: B8 Secondary Drainage Region

River(s): Letaba River System

- The Minister has, in terms of section 12 of the National Water Act, Act No 36 of 1998 (the Act), prescribed a system for classifying water resources by promulgating Regulation 810, Government Gazette 33541 dated 17 September 2010. In terms of section 13(1) of the Act the Minister must, as soon as reasonably practicable after the Minister has prescribed a system for classifying water resources and subject to subsection (4), by notice in the Gazette, determine for all or part of every significant water resource, a class in accordance with the prescribed classification system.
- 3. The Minister, in terms of section 13(1) of the Act, proposes to determine the following classes of each significant water resource for the Letaba catchment.

- 1. A summary of the water resource classes for Integrated Units of Analysis (Figure 1) and ecological categories for the Letaba catchment is set out in Table 1.
- 2. Integrated units of Analysis are classified in terms of their extent of permissible utilization and protection as either Class I: indicating high environmental protection and minimal utilization; or Class II indicating moderate protection and moderate utilization; and Class III indicating sustainable minimal protection and high utilization.
- 3. Table 1 provides the Integrated Units of Analysis, its Management Classes and its respective catchment configuration. The catchment configuration consists of a number of biophysical nodes representing river reaches or resource units. The target ecological category for each unit in the Integrated Units of Analysis is provided.


