# Guideline for Services and Processes for Estimating Fees for Persons Registered in terms of the Engineering Profession Act, 2000, (Act No.46 of 2000)

The Engineering Council of South Africa has, under <u>Section 34(2) of the Engineering Profession</u> <u>Act, 2000 (Act No. 46 of 2000)</u> provides this guideline for determining the services to be provided on projects and to facilitate estimations of appropriate fees that could be used in negotiations between Clients and Consulting Engineers.

Any amount mentioned in or fee calculated in terms of this Schedule is exclusive of Value Added Tax.

### The commencement date of this guideline shall be 1 January 2015.

ECSA has applied to the Competition Commission for an exemption from the provisions of the Competition Act 89 of 1998, in terms of which the Guideline Fees may be considered to be anticompetitive. The outcome of the exemption application may result in the discontinuation of publishing the Guideline Fees by ECSA and the use thereof by the public or full exemption may be granted.
