Invitation for public comments on Eskom's Regulatory Clearing Account (RCA) Application – third Multi Year Price Determination (MYPD3) Year 1 (2013/14)

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator (NERSA) has received Eskom's RCA application for the first year of the MYPD3 period (2013/14 financial year).

The RCA is a depository for qualifying variances between the Eskom's approved revenue and actual expenditure in the MYPD3 determination.

The Energy Regulator will assess Eskom's application following due regulatory processes:

1. Publish Eskom's application on NERSA website for stakeholder comments	13 November 2015
2. Closing date for stakeholder comments	14 December 2015
3. Public Hearings on RCA – 1 st year MYPD3	19 January 2016 to 4 February 2016 (see details below)
4. Energy Regulator decision on Eskom's RCA application	25 February 2016
