APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE BY CAPRICORN FM (PTY) LTD

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority"), hereby issues an erratum to notice number 574 of 2017, published in Government Gazette No. 41029, published on 04 August 2017.

The Authority published a notice of an amendment application of Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence for Capricorn FM. This was done in terms of section 31(4) of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005) ("the Act") read with procedures set out in Regulation 9 of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulations, Notice 279 of 2015 as published on Government Gazette No. 38641 (as amended).

The Authority hereby makes the following changes to the published notice (notice 574 of 2017): Paragraph one (1) on the second line, the word "Power FM" should be replaced by the word "Capricorn FM".
