CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING (CET) ACT OF NO 16 0F 2006 (AS AMENDED)

INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO BE APPOINTED TO SERVE ON THE COUNCILS OF TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (TVET) COLLEGES IN GAUTENG, MPUMALANGA, NORTHERN CAPE, NORTH WEST AND WESTERN CAPE

In terms of Section 10(4) (b) of the Continuing Education and Training Act, No.16 of 2006 (as amended). I, Mrs Naledi Mandisa Grace Pandor, Minister of Higher Education and Training hereby invite nominations within the period specified in the notice from the date of publication from members of: the public; vocational education and training sector; the distance learning sector, educators, organised business, organised labour, provincial government, municipal government; business community; research and science councils; and relevant non-governmental organisations.

Nominees must be persons with leadership qualities; have an understanding of the CET Act and management of public budget and expenditure; and an understanding of the government priorities and developmental agenda. Preference would be given to persons with a broader spectrum of competencies in the field of education, business, finance, marketing, information technology and corporate governance experience to contribute to the strategic direction of the Post School Education and Training (PSET) system.

The term of office of members will be five (5) years and the council shall meet at least four (4) times per annum.

Persons shall be nominated by virtue of the fact that they give expression to:

- i) Ensure that the functions of the council are performed according to the highest standard;
- ii) Ensure that the council is broadly representative of the TVET sector and its related interests;
- iii) Ensure that the council members have a thorough knowledge and understanding of the TVET sector and have a recognised qualification/s (diploma/degree), as well as verifiable experience accompanied by a solid grounding in ethical practices with a level of accountability;

- iv) Appreciate the role of the TVET colleges in the reconstruction of the TVET sector, and have a clear understanding of Governments trajectory with regards to the sector as contained in the National Development Plan: Vision for 2030;
- Ensure that members contribute to the strategic direction of a specific TVET college by
 offering knowledge and experience in strategic planning, including the development and
 delivery of college strategy, for attainment of its short, medium and long term goals;
- vi) Ensure that nominees have experience to engage and establish partnerships and linkages with industry for the purposes of Work Integrated Learning and Work Based Education for both the students and lecturers;
- vii) Ensure that the council is broadly representative of the community served by the public college in respect of race, gender or disability;
- viii) Ensure that the nominated council members reside within reasonable distance from the college they will serve, in order to reduce costs related to council and council committee meetings in terms of travel and accommodation.

Five (5) positions are available on the council for each of the colleges listed in the schedule.

Furthermore, members (nominees) are to be nominated by a person in the public (nominator) and to be seconded by a witness.

I will take into account criteria relating to representation of race, gender, geographical location and disability when I appoint the Council members. Nominators and nominees should ensure that they are conversant with the Post School Education and Training (PSET) system.
