This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, and the need to re-allocate the stopped funds to a province, as approved in terms of Section 20 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2018.

This notice affects the Education Infrastructure Grant

- a) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, the national Department of Basic Education stops the transfer of funds to Mpumalanga (R104.819 million) and North West (R125.374 million) following revised allocations by the national Department of Basic Education.
- b) In compliance with Section 20 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, the national Department of Basic Education re-allocates funds to Eastern Cape (R230.193 million), following revised allocations by the national Department of Basic Education.
