SOUTH AFRICAN WATER QUALITY GUIDELINES FOR COASTAL MARINE WATERS - NATURAL ENVIRONMENT AND MARICULTURE USE

I, Nomvula Paula Mokonyane, Minister of Environmental Affairs, hereby publish the Draft South African Water Quality Guidelines for Coastal Marine Waters - Natural Environment and Mariculture Use in terms of sections 69 and 83(1)(f)(v) of the National Environmental Management: Integrated Coastal Management Act, 2008 (Act No. 24 of 2008) for public comment.

Any person who wishes to submit representations or comments in connection with the South African Water Quality Guidelines for Coastal Marine Waters - Natural Environment and Mariculture Use is invited to do so within 30 calendar days from the date of the publication of this notice. Comments received after this time may not be considered.
