DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND CONSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT NOTICE 185 OF 2019

MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT 1944 (ACT NO. 32 OF 1944): INTENTION TO CREATE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS, SUB-DISTRICTS AND ESTABLISH DISTRICT COURTS IN THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE AS PART OF THE RATIONALISATION OF COURTS PROCESS

The Minister of Justice and Correctional Services Adv. Tshililo Michael Masutha, (MP) intends, in terms of sections 2(1)(a),(f),(h),(j).(k) and (l) of the Magistrates' Courts Act, 1944 (Act No. 32 of 1944), read with section 6 of Schedule 6 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, to:

- (a) create, in respect of the areas mentioned in Column "A" of the attached Schedule, magisterial districts as reflected under Column "B" of the attached Schedule and declare that those magisterial districts be known by the names referred to in the said Column "B":
- (b) Specify, in respect of each magisterial district mentioned under Column "B" seats of the magistracy as reflected under Column "D"
- (c) detach portions of the magisterial districts under column "B" of the said Schedule to form areas of jurisdiction of detached courts for sub-districts as reflected under column "F" and declare that those sub-districts be known by the names referred to in the said column "F";
- (d) appoint, in respect of the sub-districts mentioned under Column "F" of the Schedule to the notice, places for holding of the detached courts as reflected under Column "G" to this notice;
- (e) establish, for the districts mentioned under Column "B" and sub-districts under Column "F", courts as reflected under Columns "C" and "G" of the Schedule for the purpose of-
 - the trial of persons accused of committing any offences which shall have jurisdiction contemplated in section 89 and 92 of the Magistrates' Court Act, 1944; and

- (ii) adjudication of civil disputes contemplated in section 29(1) of the Magistrates' Court Act, 1944.
- (f) appoint, within the districts mentioned under Column "B" and sub-districts mentioned under Column "F", places for the holding of a court as reflected under Columns "E and "H" of the Schedule; and
- (g) that the places for the holding of court mentioned under Columns "E" and "H" of the Schedule; shall exercise jurisdiction over the same area of jurisdiction of the proposed seats of the districts and sub-districts as correspondingly reflected under Columns "D" and "G" of the accompanying Schedule;
- (h) define, in respect of each magisterial district mentioned under Column "B" of the Schedule to the notice, local limits as reflected on the maps accessible via the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development website;
- (i) define in respect of each sub-district mentioned under Column "F" of the Schedule to this notice, local limits as reflected on the maps accessible via the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development website.
