

NOTICE 433 OF 2019

BANKS ACT, 1990 (ACT NO. 94 OF 1990): WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE AND PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS PUBLISHED FOR COMMENT

General Notice No. 429 of 2019, which was published in Gazette No.42634 on 14 August 2019, is hereby withdrawn.

The Minister of Finance, in terms of section 90 of the Banks Act, 1990 (Act No. 94 of 1990), publishes proposed amendments to the Regulations relating to banks, for comment.
