Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedules

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 (Act No. 9 of 2021), and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to national departments and provinces in the 2021/22 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to allocate a portion of an unallocated schedule 7, Part A grant to KwaZulu-Natal following storm damages experienced by the province.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2021.

This notice affects the Provincial Emergency Housing Grant,

a) In compliance with Section 25 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 the National Department of Human Settlements allocates R3.802 million to KwaZulu-Natal from the unallocated Provincial Emergency Housing Grant (Schedule 7, Part A).
