## **Explanatory Memorandum to National and Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedules**

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 (Act No. 9 of 2021), as amended, and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to the national department of Health and provinces in the 2021/22 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to shift funds in terms of Section 16 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended, within components of the HIV, TB, Malaria and Community Outreach grant.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2021.

This notice affects the HIV, TB, Malaria and Community Outreach grant:

- a) In compliance with Section 16 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended, the national Department of Health shifts R10.760 million from the HIV/Aids component within HIV, TB, Malaria and Community Outreach grant.
- b) In compliance with Section 16 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended, the national Department of Health shifts R10.760 million to Human Papillomavirus component within the HIV, TB, Malaria and Community Outreach grant.

## **Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedule**

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 (Act No. 9 of 2021), as amended, and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2021/22 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended; and to re-allocate the stopped funds to provinces, as approved in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2021.

This notice affects the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant

- a) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended, the national Department of Human Settlements stops the transfer of funds to Gauteng (R20 million), Free State (R20 million), and Limpopo (R20 million), for the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant, following revised allocations by the national Department of Human Settlements.
- b) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021, as amended, the national Department of Human Settlements re-allocates funds to Northern Cape (R60 million), for the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant, following revised allocations by the national Department of Human Settlements.
