AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS RELATING TO CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY

Amendment of regulation 28.12

- 2. Regulation 28.12 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act. 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by the substitution of 28.12 for the following:
 - 28.12 On proof being furnished by the holder, to the satisfaction of the *Chief Inspector*, that a certificate mentioned in regulation 28.10 has been lost, defaced, or destroyed or has become dilapidated, a duplicate certificate shall be issued on payment of a fee as prescribed in the table of examination fees in regulation 28.10. The prescribed fee shall be paid in uncancelled revenue stamps. Such certificate shall bear the words 'Duplicate-Duplikaat'.
