NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN PHARMACY COUNCIL [SECTION 5(1)(a) OF THE PHARMACY ACT, 53 OF 1974]

- 1. In terms of the Regulations relating to the election of members of the South African Pharmacy Council, notice is hereby given that the process for the election of the nine (9) members to serve on the Council for the period 1 January 2024 31 December 2028, in terms of Section 5(1)(a) of the Pharmacy Act, has commenced with the publication of this Board Notice.
- 2. Every registered pharmacist who meets the following requirements is eligible for nomination:
 - (a) is a South African citizen;
 - (b) who is resident in the Republic; and
 - (c) has not served on Council for two terms.
- 3. Any registered pharmacist may nominate or second a nomination of any number of candidates, provided that such nominations/secondments do not exceed the total number of pharmacists to be elected, being nine (9).
- 4. Nominations should be completed on the Council website at www.sapc.za.org. In order to submit a nomination/s, a registered pharmacist who wishes to nominate a candidate should log in to their secure profile on the Council in order to commence the process.
- 5. The online nomination process will ensure that:
 - (a) the pharmacist being nominated is not restricted from nomination;
 - (b) the full names of the pharmacist being nominated will be as they appear in the register of Council:
 - (c) the candidate shall accept the nomination by completing the nomination process, uploading a copy of their identity document, and providing a 400-word curriculum vitae in English.
- 6. All online nominations must be completed no later than **16:00** on **Monday, 08 September 2023**.
- 7. All nominations in respect of which any of these provisions have not been complied with, or which are not received by the aforesaid time, will be invalid.
- 8. Persons who require assistance with the nomination process may send an email to elections@sapc.za.org with a contact telephone number where they can be contacted during office hours (Monday Friday, 09h00 16h00) and the Office of the Returning Officer will provide assistance.
