COMPETITION ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 89 OF 1998)**

1. By virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of section 10(3)(b)(iv) of the Competition Act, 1998 (Act No. 89 of 1998), I Ebrahim Patel, Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition, hereby -
  - (a) extend the current period of designation of the South African Petroleum Industry Association (SAPIA), as determined in Government Gazette No. 49779 of 28 November 2023, for a further three (3) months until 31 May 2024; and
  - (b) determine that this Notice shall be in force and effect as from 1 March 2024.
