The Securities and Exchange Commission (the Commission) is a Statutory body established under the Securities Act, Cap. 354 of the Laws of Zambia (Repealed) and whose existence is continued under the Securities Act, No. 41 of 2016 (the Securities Act) The Commission has a Statutory mandate to protect investors in the capital market.

Secition 4(2) of the Securities Act empowers the ommission to exempt persons or securities from its requirements. In excercise of the powers vested in the Commission aforesaid, the Commission hereby notifies the public that-

- The temporary exemption granted to the Board of Directors of a listed company, or a company whose securities are registered with the commission, from reporting on the effectiveness of the company's internal control system in its annual report as required by section 147 (2) of the Securities Act, is extended to 31st December, 2019.
- 2. - This extension does not preclude auditors from the requirement to audit the annual financial statement of listed companies or companies whose securities are registered with the commission as provided under section 148 (2) of the Securities Act.
