TRADE AGREEMENT WITH THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

Preferential Duty Certificates

Manufacturers wishing to obtain an allocation for the six-month period commencing on the 1st July, 1980, for the

goods requiring preferential duty certificates and mentioned in the Schedule, should apply to the Secretary for Commerce and Industry, Private Bag 7708, Causeway, not later than 6th June, 1980.

Manufacturers wishing to obtain an allocation for the coming period in respect of clothing mentioned in Part IV of Annexure B to the Trade Agreement between Zimbabwe and the Republic of South Africa (published in Rhodesia Government Notice 811 of 1964), should apply to the Zimbabwe Clothing Council.

The following information must be given in the letter of application: name, address, description of goods for which allocation is required. South African tariff item, as quoted in the Trade Agreement, allocation requested (quantity and value), present annual capacity in respect of goods concerned (quantity and value).

Notes

1. Attention is drawn to the special provisions for Zimbabwean content, as set out in the agreement.
2. Allocations will be expressed in terms of value for duty purposes, as laid down in the South African Customs and Excise Act.
3. Certificates will be valid for two months from the date of issue, provided that certificates issued during the last month on an allocation period will be valid only until one month after the end of that period.
4. If an allocation is not used in full by a manufacturer to whom it is granted, the manufacturer's allocation may be reduced in the following period by an appropriate amount.
