Liabilities

Public Notice to Furnish Returns for the Year of Assessment Ended on the 31st March, 1980

NOTICE is hereby given that all persons falling within the classification set out below, and all persons to whom forms have been sent, are required to furnish returns for assessment within 30 days after the date of this notice.

Returns are required from:

- 1. Every person whose income for the year ended on the 31st March, 1980, exceeded \$2 400, and who—
 - (a) had his wife living with him or wholly maintained her during any part of that period, and was not separated by judicial order or written agreement; or
 - (b) had the custody of, and maintained during more than half of the period, an unmarried, lawful child of his own who was born on or after the 1st April, 1959.
 - Note.—The income of a woman married with or without community of property, and not separated from her husband under a judicial order or written agreement, and not living apart from her husband and wholly maintaining herself, is deemed to be income of her husband for the purposes of the Income Tax Act, and

must be included by him in his returns of income required to be rendered by him under the Act.

Assets

- Every person (other than a company) who does not fall within the terms of paragraph 1, and whose income for the year ended on the 31st March, 1980, exceeded \$1 500.
- The representative taxpayer, as defined in section 42 of the Income Tax Act [Chapter 181], of—
 - (a) every company or trust;
 - (b) every person falling within the terms of paragraphs 1 and 2 who—
 - (i) is permanently or temporarily absent from Zimbabwe;
 - (ii) is a minor;
 - (iii) is mentally disordered or defective or is under legal disability;
 - (iv) receives income under the decree of any court or judge through a receiver or other person;
 - (v) died during the year ended on the 31st March, 1980, or who died after the 31st March, 1980, before rendering a return of income for the year ended on the 31st March, 1980.
- Every person, whether liable to taxation or not, to whom a form has been sent.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complemental use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the Gazette itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the Gazette.

·1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

- (2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclama-
- (3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.
