## SCHEDULE

## GENERAL PARDON AND REMISSION OF SENTENCE IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN OFFENCES COMMITTED BEFORE INDEPENDENCE DAY

*Interpretation*

## 1. (1) In this Schedule—

"fixed date" means the 21st August, 1980, being the date on which this Schedule received the approval of the President;

"minor offence" means any statutory offence the maximum penalty for which is a fine only or a sentence of imprisonment, with or without the option of a fine, not exceeding eighteen months;

"specified offence" means—

- (a) any contravention of paragraph 15 of the First Schedule to the Defence Act [Chapter 94], paragraph 6 of the Schedule to the Police Act [Chapter 98] of paragraph 7 of the First Schedule to the Prisons Act [Chapter 21];
- (b) theft of stock or produce as defined in the Stock Theft Act [Chapter 72];
- (c) receiving, knowing it to have been stolen, any stock or produce as defined in the Stock Theft Act [Chapter 72];
- (d) any contravention of any of the provisions of the Stock Theft Act [Chapter 72], other than section 7;
- (e) any conspiracy, incitement or attempt to commit any offence referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c) or (d);
- (f) being an accessory after the fact to any offence referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d) or (e);

(g) any offence committed on or after the 1st March, 1980 and before the 18th April, 1980, which, if it had been committed before the 1st March, 1980, would have qualified for the pardon granted by section 2 as read with section 3(1)(c) of the Amnesty (General Pardon) Ordinance, 1980 (Ordinance No. 12 of 1980).

## (2) For the purposes of this Schedule—

- (a) a person who has been sentenced to imprisonment but is on bail pending his appeal against the conviction or sentence concerned shall be deemed to be serving the sentence;
- (b) a sentence of imprisonment or detention imposed on a member of the Defence Forces, the Police Force or the Prison Service by a court martial, board of officers or other tribunal under the provisions of the Defence Act [Chapter 94], the Police Act [Chapter 98] or the Prisons Act [Chapter 21] providing for the discipline of such members shall be deemed to be a sentence of imprisonment imposed by the court.

*Pardon in respect of specified offences and minor offences*

2. A free pardon is hereby granted to every person in respect of the commission by him before the 18th April, 1980, of any specified offence or minor offence for which he has not, on the fixed date, been sentenced.

*Remission of sentence in respect of specified offences*

3. Every person who on the fixed date is serving a determinate sentence of imprisonment imposed on him, whether with or without the option of a fine, for any specified offence committed before the 18th April, 1980, is hereby granted a full remission of the remainder of the sentence of imprisonment imposed on him by the court.

*Remission of sentence of 18 months or less*

4. Every person not referred to in paragraph 3 who on the fixed date is serving a determinate sentence of imprisonment which—

- (a) was imposed on him, whether with or without the option of a fine, on or after the 18th April, 1980, in respect of an offence committed by him before that date; and
- (b) is of eighteen months' duration or less or which will expire within the period of eighteen months next following the fixed date;

is hereby granted a full remission of that sentence of imprisonment or the remainder of that sentence of imprisonment as the case may be.

*General remission of one third of every sentence of imprisonment*

5. Every person not referred to in paragraph 2, 3 or 4 who on the fixed date is serving a determinate sentence of imprisonment which was imposed on him, whether with or without the option of a fine, on or after the 18th April, 1980, in respect of an offence committed by him before that date is hereby granted a remission of one third of the sentence of imprisonment imposed on him by the court, which remission shall be in addition to any other remission of that sentence that may be granted or earned under any other law.

## Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the Gazette itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the Gazette.



1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator must be clearly effected in blue or black ink:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards — not, for instance, 7, 7a, 7b, 8, et cetera.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

(a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or

(b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy, and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

(a) the work involved is of a straightforward and non-tabular nature; and

(b) the total volume of work on hand for the time being permits its acceptance.

## SHERIFF'S SALES

## Conditions of sale

1. The sale is conducted in terms of the rules of the High Court, which provide that it shall be without reserve but subject to the condition that the Sheriff requires to be satisfied that the highest price offered is reasonable, having regard to the circumstances of time and place and the state of the property.
2. 9.
