EMERGENCY POWERS ACT [CHAPTER 83]

Emergency Powers (Prohibition of Objectionable Souvenirs) Order, 1981

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Home Affairs has, in terms of section 3 of the Emergency Powers (Maintenance of Law and Order) Regulations, 1980, made the following order:—

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Prohibition of Objectionable Souvenirs) Order, 1981.

(2) This order shall come into operation on the 1st September, 1981.

2. In this order-

"public place" includes any-

(a) road, street, thoroughfare, lane, footpath or bridge to which the public has access;

(b) building, part of a building, police station, police camp, stream, river, lake, dam, swimming-pool, garden, park, racecourse, open space, open-air theatre, drive-in theatre, aerodrome, sports-ground, recreation-ground, show-ground, parade-ground or other ground, whether enclosed or not, to which the public or any section of the public has access, or is permitted to have access, whether on payment or otherwise, and whether or not the right of admission thereto is reserved;

"U.D.I. period" means the period commencing on the 11th November, 1965, and ending immediately before the 18th April, 1980.

- 3. No person shall, without the authority of the Minister or other lawful authority—
  - (a) import, manufacture or sell; or
- (b) use or wear in any public place; any article which (whether by reason of any representation of or reference, direct or indirect, to any matter specified in the Schedule, or for any other reason) purports to be, or is reasonably capable of being taken as, a souvenir or memento of the U.D.I. period, or of any action taken against those seeking to overthrow the Government during that period.

#### SCHEDULE (Section 3)

- 1. The word "Rhodesia" or "Rhodesian".
- The name of any Prime Minister, Minister or other prominent public figure of the U.D.I. period.
- 3. Any national flag used in Zimbabwe during the U.D.I. period.
- The name or insignia of any unit of the security forces of the Government in power during the U.D.I. period.
- 5. Any feature of, or event occurring during, the U.D.I. period, including, without derogation from the generality of the foregoing, any of the exploits or activities or operational areas of the security forces of the Government in power during that period.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in-

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complemental use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the Gazette itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the Gazette.

- 1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.
- (2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclama-

#### Conditions of sale

## SHERIFF'S SALES

- 1.
