## ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Public Holidays: Temporary Authorities for the Operation of Motor-omnibuses

It is hereby notified that temporary authorities for the Christmas holidays may be applied for to cover the period from the 9th December, 1982, to the 3rd January, 1983. All applications should be in by the 26th November, 1982.

Temporary variations will be granted only to cover the exact route or routes of the permit being varied, or a route changed on account of circumstances, together with any conditions which may apply, and will authorize the service on such routes on an "as and when required" basis.

Temporary permits will be granted only for the operation of roadworthy spare motor-omnibuses as shown on form R.M.T. 27, held in this office, over routes already served by the operator in question, under the authority of specific road service permits. The route or routes must be specifically described, the permit numbers must be quoted and the fare-tables (in duplicate) must accompany the application.

## Applications in Connexion with Road Service Permits

## One Hundred and Sixty-second State Lottery: Units One, Two, Three and Four

NOTICE is hereby given, for general information, that units one, two, three and four of the one hundred and sixty-second State lottery will be drawn in public, under direction from the Minister of Finance, at the State Lottery Hall, Harare, at 1.30 p.m. on the following dates:

Unit one: 12th January, 1983.

The first prize in unit one will be \$60 000.

The first prize in units two, three and four will be \$50 000.

## Conditions for each unit

- Based on the face value of all tickets sold or issued free, up to 25 per cent. of the total subscription may be reserved for social service, public welfare or relief of distress.

## Prizes

The prize-fund will be distributed as follows—

- Ordinary prizes: first, as above; second, \$15 000; third, \$7 500. Introducers: \$1 000; \$500; \$250.
- The remainder of the prize-money will be distributed in smaller, ordinary, introducers' and introducers' jackpot prizes. If, in the opinion of the Minister of Finance, the prize-fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above shall be reduced as directed by that Minister.
- Two introducers' jackpot prizes: prize, \$50; introducer, \$500.  
Only full dollar tickets issued against one written order for 14 full tickets in one unit are eligible to win these prizes, provided that such written order has been compiled at one and the same time. Prizes not won will be carried forward and used to increase the jackpot prizes in the following unit. These prizes will be drawn after the draw for ordinary prizes has been completed. (Quarter-tickets without counterfoils are excluded.)

## 3. Double and treble prizes

Any lottery prize of \$200 or less won by a full dollar lottery ticket will be (i) *doubled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize-ticket three additional one-dollar lottery tickets in the same unit; or (ii) *trebled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize-ticket seven additional one-dollar lottery tickets in the same unit; provided that, in order to qualify for the double or treble prize, the counterfoils of all tickets submitted must have exactly the same name

and address as that found on the counterfoil of the prize-winning ticket. (Nearly the same is not sufficient.) To give examples of possible differences in the counterfoils: "J. Jones", "John Jones" and "Mr. J. Jones"; "Byo." and "Bulawayo"; "Rd." and "Road"; "Box" and "P.O. Box". Multiple prizes do not apply to introducers' prizes. (Quarter-tickets are excluded.)

## 4. The draw

- The numbers of all tickets sold will participate in the draw for all prizes. In the event of the figure 0000 being drawn, this will represent ticket number 10 000 in the particular serial.
- If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize-number, a "no draw" shall be announced, and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not, in itself, be considered as a fault. Examples of faults are—
  - one or more balls appearing before control-button is pressed;
  - control-button pressed before all balls are in the drums.
- Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], when a prize-number has been passed and recorded, no subsequent claim that a "no draw" should have been announced will be considered.
- Only one ordinary prize can be won by one ticket-number (see clause 2). If a full dollar ticket is drawn, the prize is payable to the party whose name appears on the counterfoil. No trading in dollar tickets will be recognized by the State Lottery. If the number drawn represents an unsold ticket or a ticket-number which has already drawn an ordinary prize, a "no draw" shall be announced and the prize shall be drawn again. ## 5. Payment of prizes

- All cash prizes are free from taxation by the Government, and are payable, in full, by cheque drawn on The Standard Bank Limited.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

(a) exceed 10 pages of typing on A4 paper; or

(b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy, and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

(a) the work involved is of a straightforward and non-tabular nature; and

(b) the total volume of work on hand for the time being permits its acceptance.

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in these conditions, any copy—

(a) which is of national importance, and which is originated as a matter of urgent necessity, may, by prior arrangement, be accepted late for the current week;

(b) may, due to shortage of staff or to technical considerations, be delayed until conditions permit its processing.

(c) that the correction of such error is legally necessary.

(2) If a drafting error is not detected before publication, the originating ministry or department is required to draft its own correcting notice, take it to the Attorney-General for vetting, and pay for such notice to be published.

(3) For the removal of doubt—

(a) a typographical error is made by a typographer;

(b) a typist's error is classed as a drafting error by reason of the fact that the officer responsible for drafting failed to check the typist's work.

## SHERIFF'S SALES

## Conditions of sale

1. The sale is conducted in terms of the rules of the High Court, which provide that it shall be without reserve but subject to the condition that the Sheriff requires to be satisfied that the highest price offered is reasonable, having regard to the circumstances of time and place and the state of the property.
2. 8. Immediately after conclusion of the auction, the highest bidder shall, unless other arrangements are made with the auctioneer, deposit with the auctioneer an amount sufficient to cover the auctioneer's commission, and either—
  - (a) advise the Commissioner appointed by the Sheriff, attending the sale, of the manner in which he intends to make payment of the purchase-price and other costs and charges in terms of these conditions, and satisfy the Commissioner as to his bona fides and ability to meet his obligations; or
  - (b) effect payment to the Commissioner of the whole of the purchase-price in cash or by cheque or bank draft drawn to the order of the Sheriff.
9. The purchase-money, if not paid in full to the Commissioner at the conclusion of the auction, shall be paid on or before the registration of the transfer of the property into the name of the purchaser, unless the Sheriff approves other arrangements for discharging the amount due by the purchaser.
10. The purchaser shall be liable to pay interest at the rate of nine per cent. per annum in respect of any unpaid balance of the purchase-price, with effect from seven days after the date of confirmation of the sale by the Sheriff.
11. If the purchaser fails to make payment of the purchase-price and other costs and charges in terms of these conditions of sale, or fails to comply with any conditions of the sale contained herein, the Sheriff shall have the right to apply to a judge of the High Court to have the sale cancelled, and to hold the purchaser liable for any loss or damages sustained, or to employ any other remedy which he may have. In the event of the sale being cancelled, the purchaser shall not be entitled to any increase which the property may realize at a subsequent sale.
12. The property is sold as represented by the title-deeds, the Sheriff not holding himself liable for any deficiency whatsoever, and renouncing all excess; and the Sheriff does not hold himself responsible for the determination of the boundaries and beacons, which shall be the responsibility of the purchaser.
