TRADE AGREEMENT WITH THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

Preferential Duty Certificates

MANUFACTURERS wishing to obtain an allocation for the six-month period commencing on the 1st January, 1984, for the goods requiring preferential duty certificates, and mentioned in the Schedule, should apply to the Secretary for Trade and Commerce, Private Bag 7708, Causeway, not later than the 22nd December, 1983.

 Attention is drawn to the special provisions for Zimbabwean content, as set out in the agreement.

Allocation will be expressed in terms of value for duty purposes, as laid down in the South African Customs and Excise Act.

 Certificates will be valid for two months from the date of issue, provided that certificates issue during the last month of an allocation period will be valid only until one month after the end of that period.

4. If an allocation is not used in full by a manufacturer to whom it is granted, the manufacturer's allocation may be reduced in the following period by an appropriate
