## ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

### Renewal of Road Service Permits

HOLDERS of road service permits which are due to expire on the 31st January, 1984, are reminded that applications for renewal thereof must be lodged, on form R.M.T. 8, with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway, not later than the 1st January, 1984.

Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] provides that the Controller shall not consider any application for the renewal of a road service permit unless it is lodged with him at least 30 days before its date of expiry.

All holders of road service permits which expire in January, 1984, are hereby notified that, in terms of section 8 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], the holders of such permits are required, when submitting applications for the renewal of their permits, to substantiate the rate of utilization of each permit during the entire period of validity ending in January, 1984. Failure to show that the relevant road service permits were being used for purposes for which such permits were originally issued could result in such permits not being renewed. The provisions of section 12 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] will be applied in all cases where holders fail to substantiate permit usage.

## ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

### School-opening, 1984: Temporary Authorities for the Operation of Motor-omnibuses

## Emergency Scheme for the Restricted Use of Water

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of section 134A of the Urban Councils Act [Chapter 214], that, further to notice 187/1983, published on the 4th November, 1983, and the 11th November, 1983, the City Council of Mutare has, because of the critical fall in storage-level of the Odzani Dam (Lake Alexander), resolved that further restrictions be introduced.

Water supplied to every stand in the city, as well as in the former local government areas of Sakubva and Danganvura, is to be restricted to 500 litres per day, giving a monthly consumption of 15 to 15,5 cubic metres, depending on the number of days in a particular month. Any consumption in excess of the 500 litres per day will be subject to a surcharge.

The rates of surcharge, on a daily basis, per dwelling-house or per flat, for exceeding the restrictions will be as follows:

The fore-going figures are based on average monthly consumption. Please note that 1 cubic metre is equal to 1 000 litres.

It should be noted that the above scheme is in addition to the restrictions previously advertised, namely, prohibiting the use of furrows for irrigating gardens, the use of hose-pipes and sprinklers for watering gardens and washing cars. In addition, the topping up of swimming-pools and the use of buckets is also prohibited. The surcharge scheme will be introduced with effect from, and including, Friday, the 18th November, 1983, until further notice.
