- (a) that a restriction disc be inserted in the water-meter for a period of two consecutive meter readings if any domestic or commercial consumer exceeds the ration by 10 per cent or more;
- (b) to continue the imposition of a surcharge of \$5 per kilolitre for every additional kilolitre of water used in excess of the ration;
- (c) to continue the ban on the use of hose-pipes;
- (d) to prohibit the use of automatic flushing systems out of normal working hours.

Note:—1 cubic metre=1 kilolitre=1 000 litres=220 gallons.

It is once again emphasised that the success of the rationing scheme will depend on the positive co-operation of the public to conserve water, and the support of the public is therefore of paramount importance.

Failure to reduce over-all consumption to acceptable limits will mean that even stricter measures will have to be imposed.
