PLANT PESTS AND DISEASES ACT [CHAPTER 128]

Extension of Growing Period: Cotton

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Lands, Agriculture and Rural Settlement has, in terms of section 4 of the Plant Pests and Diseases (Cotton) Regulations, 1980, exempted growers in the lowveld districts from compliance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 3 of those regulations and growers in the rest of the growing areas from compliance with the provisions of paragraph (b) of the said section in respect of cotton plants of the current season the picking of which has not been completed on or before the 1st August, 1985, and the 15th August, 1985, respectively.

The exemptions are granted subject to the following conditions-

- (a) that in the lowveld districts where picking is completed on or after the 1st August, 1985, and before the 15th August, 1985, all cotton plants, including stalks and roots thereof, shall be destroyed immediately after completion of such picking; and
- (b) that, in the rest of the growing areas, where picking is completed on or after the 15th August, 1985, and before the 10th September, 1985, all cotton plants, including stalks and roots thereof, shall be destroyed immediately after completion of such picking; and
- (c) that all cotton plants, including stalks and roots thereof, shall, in any event be destroyed on or before the 15th August, 1985, in respect of the Makonde, Mazowe Valley and lowveld districts and on or before the 10th September, 1985, in respect of the rest of the growing areas, which shall be the last days of the period covered by the exemptions.
