INTERIM REPORT

Recovery in domestic economic activity which began with the breaking last summer of three successive drought years continued to provide a broadly favourable business environment in the first half of the current financial year. Although the volume of tobacco produced in 1984/85 was about 12% lower, maize and wheat deliveries were virtually double those of the previous cropping season and some 16% more cotton was marketed. While the volume of mineral production fell marginally in calendar 1985 the volume of secondary manufacturing output rose by over 12%. Foreign trade also expanded rapidly indicated by the growth of nearly 29% and over 20%, respectively, in the value of exports and imports during the first eight months of the calendar year. Despite a delayed start, rainfall in 1985/86 in the important cropping areas in the north of the country appears to have been generally sufficient to ensure that the rate of real GNP growth in 1985, estimated at about 5% has not so far at least been overly checked.

As a result of the generally expansionary financial conditions the Bank's gross unaudited net operating income, after provision for taxation and after transfers to internal reserves, increased to \$3 390 000 compared with \$3 196 000 for the first half of the previous financial year. Earnings per share amounted to 25.90 cents compared with 24.42 cents in the corresponding period of last financial year.

The posted increase in income would have been significantly greater but for two major reasons. First, during the period there has been a very substantial increase in expenditure, over half of which was directly accounted for by higher staff costs resulting primarily from legislated wage awards. Second, the costs of borrowing increased steadily throughout the period with the key three-month NCD rate indicator averaging 10% in March, its highest level since the first half of 1984. Despite the rise in income, therefore, the dividend has been maintained at the same level to strengthen the Bank's reserves so as to assist in further expanding and improving its network and facilities in accordance with official policy of providing banking services to an increasing proportion of the population, especially in the rural areas.

Provided further statutory wage increases proposed for later this year are moderate, and liquidity conditions do not get significantly tighter it will be possible, despite the necessary provisions already noted, to at least match last year's performance over the whole twelve month to next September.

Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance, 7, 7a, 7b, 8, et cetera.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.
