The interests of all employers engaged in manufacturing, either in whole or in part, all types of furniture irrespective of the material used, and wholesale distribution thereof, including the following constitute. the following operations-

- making loose covers, cushions and curtains;

making or repairing box-spring mattresses and frames for upholstering;

manufacturing, polishing or repolishing, staining spraying furniture or cabinets for musical instruments or radio, radiogram or television cabinets;

processes in the manufacture of bedding, bolsters or cushions, inner-spring mattresses, overlays and pillows;

- reparing, re-upholstering or repolishing in establishments in which the production of furniture, or any operation associated with the final preparation of any article of furniture, for sale, either in whole or in part, is carried
- warehousing or distributing wholesale—any one or more of the products described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (g) when carried out in conjunction with the manufacture of such products;
