MINES AND MINERALS ACT [CHAPTER 165]

Exclusive Prospecting Order No. 625: Gweru Mining District

THE following order is published in terms of subsection (2) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]:—
"I, Richard Chemist Hove, Minister of Mines, with the approval of the President, hereby, in terms of subsection (1) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], make an exclusive prospecting order in favour of Zimbabwe Mining Development Corporation, over the area described hereunder, in the Gweru mining district, in relation to map reference Insukamini 1929 B3 of the Third Edition, of the scale 1:50 000, produced by the Surveyor-General, subject to the following conditions:

(a) the order is made in respect of tungsten, copper, nickel and precious metals;

(b) the concession holder shall carry out prospecting operations in a manner satisfactory to the Minister of Mines.

Zimbabwe Mining Development Corporation is authorized, in terms of subsection (4) of section 94 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], to prospect on all registered base mineral blocks which were not being worked or developed on the 16th of September, 1986, being the date of the lodging of the application for this order.

Description of area

An area approximately 5 244 hectares, situated in the Gweru mining district immediately adjacent to the southern boundary of the area reserved by the Zimbabwe Geological Survey in conjunction with the Canadian International Development Agency, (known as Area 1), bounded by a line commencing at a point where an unnamed stream crosses a track (grid reference 35KQJ76165357); thence due east along the southern boundary of the reserved area for a distance of approximately 9.0 kilometres to a point where a track meets the western boundary of Oxfordshire Farm (grid reference 35KQJ85215342); thence on a true bearing of approximately 115° for a distance of approximately 4,0 kilometres to a point where a track crosses 29° 45′ at the edge of the map (grid reference 35KQJ88825170); thence due south along longitude 29° 45′ for a distance of approximately 1,15 kilometres to an intersection with a dirt road approximately 7 kilometres north-west of Gweru (grid reference 35KQJ88795055); thence on a true bearing of approximately 246° for a distance of approximatelf 9,85 kilometres to a point where the southern boundaries of Cornwall and Devon farms intersect (grid reference 35KQJ79724670); thence on a true bearing of approximately 333° for a distance of approximately 7,75 kilometres to the starting-point.

The rights granted under this order may be exercised for a period of three years, from the 15th January, 1988, to the 14th January, 1991, inclusive.
