ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Easter, Schools and Independence Holidays, 1989: Temporary Authority for the Operation of Motor-omnibuses

IT is hereby notified that temporary authorities for the Easter Holidays, First Term Schools closing and opening periods and the Independence Holidays, 1989, may be applied for to cover either the first period (22nd March to 20th April, 1989); or the second period (12th May to 29th May, 1989) and/or both periods.

Applicants wishing to cover the double period are required to pay a double application fee.

Temporary variations will be granted only to cover the exact route or routes of the permit being varied, together with any conditions which may apply and will authorize, on such routes, operations on an "as and when required" basis.

Temporary permits will be granted only for the operation of roadworthy spare motor-omnibuses, as shown on form R.M.T. 27, held in this office, over routes already served by the operator in question, under the authority of a specific road service permit. The route(s) must be specifically described, the permit numbers must be quoted and the fare-tables in duplicate must accompany the application.

Applications should be in by the 10th March, 1989, addressed to the Controller of Road Motor Transportation and either—

- (a) posted to P.O. Box 8332, Causeway; or
- (b) delivered to Thirteenth Floor, Kaguvi Building, Fourth Street/Central Avenue, Harare.

Note.—Operators are advised that unless current R.M.T. 27 Schedules are submitted as prescribed in section 26 of the Road Motor Transportation (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations, 1972 in terms of section 12 (2) (g) of [Chapter 262], their applications will not be accepted.
