Proposal to Declare Specified Processes

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Health proposes, in terms of subsection (2) of section 5 of the Atmospheric Pollution Prevention Act [Chapter 318], to declare the following processes to be specified processes:

Uranium

Any process in which-

- (i) any ore or concentrate or any material containing uranium or its compounds is treated for the production of uranium or its alloys or its compounds; or
- (ii) any volatile compounds of uranium are manufactured or used; or
- (iii) uranium or its compounds are manufactured, fashioned or fabricated by any dry process giving rise to dust or fumes.

Any person who has any objection to this proposal is called upon to lodge his objection, in writing, with the Secretary for Health, P.O. Box 8204, Causeway, within the period of six weeks following the date of publication of this
