Applications in Connexion with Road Service Permits

Road Motor Transportation (Emergency Taxi-cab) Regulations, 1983: Approval of Fares

IT is hereby notified, in terms of section 10 of the Road Motor Transportation (Emergency Taxi-cab) Regulations, 1983, that the Controller of Road Motor Transportation has approved the fares for the Municipality of Gweru as follows:—

- (a) 50 cents within a five-kilometre radius of a pick-up point; and
