## STATE LOTTERIES ACT [CHAPTER 317]

One Hundred and Ninety-sixth Lottery: Units One, Two, Three and Four

NOTICE is hereby given, for general information, that units one, two, three and four of the one hundred and ninety-sixth lottery will be drawn in public, under the direction of the Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development at the venues stated below—

Unit One—13th September, 1991—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare.

Unit Two—11th October, 1991—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare

Unit Three—8th November, 1991—12.30 p.m.—Queens Hall, Mutare.

Unit Four—6th December, 1991—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare.

The first prize will be \$50 000 in all units.

*Conditions for each unit*

1. (a) Tickets with counterfoils will be sold at \$2 each.
- (b) Based on the face value of all tickets sold or issued free, up to 25 per cent. of the total subscription may be reserved for social services, public welfare or relief of distress.

2. *Prizes*

The prize-fund will be distributed as follows—

- (i) Ordinary prizes: First—as above, Second—\$15 000, Third—\$7 500.

Introducers—\$1 000; \$500; \$250.

- (ii) The remainder of the prize-money will be distributed in smaller ordinary, introducers, introducers' jackpot and consolation prizes. If, in the opinion of the Minister, the prize-fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by that Minister.

- (iii) *Two introducers' jackpot prizes of \$1 000 each*

Only tickets issued against one written order for 12 tickets or more in one unit are eligible to win these prizes, provided such written order has been compiled at one and the same time. Prizes not won will be carried forward and used to increase the jackpot prizes in the following unit. These prizes will be drawn after the draw for ordinary prizes has been completed. There will be no double or treble prizes.

3. *Double and treble prizes*

Any ordinary lottery prize of \$200 or less, won by a lottery ticket will be (i) *doubled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize-ticket, three additional lottery tickets in the same unit, or (ii) *trebled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize-ticket, seven additional lottery tickets in the same unit, provided that in order to qualify for the double and treble prizes, the counterfoils of all tickets submitted must have exactly the same name and address as that found on the counterfoil of the prize-winning ticket. (Nearly the same is not sufficient). To give examples of possible differences in the counterfoils—"J. Jones", "John Jones" and "Mr. J. Jones"; "Byo." and "Bulawayo"; "Rd." and "Road"; "Box" and "P.O. Box". Multiple prizes do not apply to introducers' prizes and consolation prizes.

4. *The draw*

- (a) The number of all tickets sold will participate in the draw for all prizes.
- (b) If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize-number, a "no draw" shall be announced, and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not in itself be considered as a fault. Examples of faults are—
  - (i) one or more balls appearing before the control-button is pressed;
  - (ii) control-button pressed before all balls are in the drums.
- (c) Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], when a prize-number has been passed and recorded, no subsequent claim that a "no draw" should have been announced will be considered.
- (d) Only *one* ordinary prize can be won by one ticket number (see clause 2 above). If a ticket is drawn, the prize is payable to the party whose name appears on the counterfoil. No trading in tickets will be

recognized by the State Lottery. If the number drawn represents an unsold ticket, a "no draw" will be announced and the prize will be drawn again. If the number drawn for a higher prize represents a number of a ticket which has already won a smaller prize, the bigger prize will be payable. Except as provided by subclause (iii) of clause 2 above. Prizes will be drawn in order of the value.

- (e) Only the lucky names and towns of the purchasers of winning-tickets will be announced, names are not announced or published (this does not apply to winners of prizes drawn to promote the lottery).

5. *Payment of prizes*

- (a) All cash prizes are free from taxation by the Government, and are payable, in full, by cheque.
- (b) Tickets are official receipts in themselves and prizes will be paid out on production of the winning-ticket. The Minister may authorize payment of a prize-won by a lottery ticket, without production of the ticket.
- (c) If a syndicate wins a prize, it must nominate one or two members to whom the cheque is to be made payable on behalf of the syndicate.

6. Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], no responsibility will attach to the Minister of Finance, or the Director or Trustees of the State Lotteries on account of the illegibility of counterfoils, errors or omissions on the part of the ticket-seller, purchasers, press or printers or on account of loss or theft of a ticket.

7. The financial statement and prize-list will be published in *The Herald*, Harare, and *The Chronicle*, Bulawayo, after the draw. Results-sheets may be obtained from official ticket-sellers or the Director, and, on request, will be posted to any subscriber who gives an address outside Zimbabwe.

While every effort will continue to be made to publish *Extraordinaries* on the required dates, copy must be submitted timeously so that it can be programmed into the printing workflow as soon as it is available.

## Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained, elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator, must be clearly effected in blue or black ink, using editorial marks—not proof-reader's marks:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance, 7, 7b, 8, *et cetera*.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

(a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or

(b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

(a) the work involved is of a straight forward and non-tabular nature; and

(b) the total volume of work on hand for the time being permits its acceptance.

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in these conditions, any copy—
