 - 0-50 m³ per month-no surcharge;
 - 50-60 m³ per month-\$1 per m³ and part thereof of excess consumption;
 - 60 m³ per month and above—\$5 per m³ or part thereof of the excess consumption;
- (e) in the event of the consumers under (b) and (c) above exceeding the average limit a surcharge calculated as follows shall be payable:

0-average limit—no surcharge; excess of average limit—\$10 per m³ or part thereof. For the purpose of this scheme, a month shall be construed to mean a period of 30 consecutive days.
