MINES AND MINERALS ACT [CHAPTER 165]

Exclusive Prospecting Order No. 737: Bulawayo Mining District

THE following order is published in terms of subsection (2) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]: of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]:
