GROUP RESULTS ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER, 1996

INTRODUCTION

Shareholders are aware of the restructuring exercise which commenced in earnest at the beginning of 1996. Regrettably, due to ongoing consultations with various stakeholders, it was not feasible to publish the Group's Results for the year ended 30 September 1996 as originally scheduled, in the first week of November, 1996.

As part of the restructure, Management entered into negotiations with the financial authorities on the best way to tackle the group's bad and doubtful book. After considerable time and effort on the part of all concerned, an acceptable situation has now been reached, allowing the Board and Management to advise shareholders of the situation. We wish to thank the Ministry of Finance and the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe for their guidance in this matter.

The Group has sold without recourse, effective 30 September 1996, book debts amounting to \$1 178 million for a sale price of \$1 000 million cash with the loss on sale of \$178 million written off against provisions previously created and current income. Certain of the financing costs of the purchasing company will be borne by the Group over the next five years. These costs will however be offset by increased income generated by the sale proceeds.

The customers whose bad debts have been sold to the purchasing company will be advised shortly of their new status and the requirements expected of them. It is the intention, however, of this purchasing company to recover in full all such bad debts.

In order to further strengthen the capital adequacy of the Zimbabwe Banking Corporation Limited it has been agreed, exceptionally, that the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe will, temporarily, take up new capital in the Bank. Sixteen million convertible preference shares of \$1 each will be issued to the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe at par for cash. This arrangement will have the effect of diluting FINHOLD's interest in the Zimbabwe Banking Corporation Limited.

The issue of the preference shares is the first step towards the strengthening of the Bank's balance sheet and at an appropriate time ordinary shareholders of FINHOLD will be requested to participate in further capital building exercises.

Full details of the above transactions will be given in the forthcoming 1996 Group Annual Report.

The Board and Management are positive about the future of the Group. Apart from improving the Group's liquidity and capital adequacy, the disposal of these bad debts gives the opportunity for a more focused and effective management of the reduced book and creates conditions for future growth prospects.

GROUP RESULTS

Although total interest income and interest expense for the year contracted, the net interest income for the period under review increased to \$323,4 million, which was 54,2% above that for the same period last year.

Non-interest income continued to make a substantial and steady contribution to profitability.

The net trading income of \$218,1 million was 28,7% above the figure for the same period last year. While this was satisfactory and in line with projections, the significant deterioration of certain sections of the Group loan portfolio particularly in the commercial bank, culminated in the increased charge for specific and general risk provisions, a large part of which related to the disposal at a discount of certain book debts mentioned above. This, coupled with the costs of the restructuring exercise, has resulted in income before taxation decreasing by 34,4% from \$81,3 million in 1995 to \$53,3 million in 1996. Net income after taxation of \$35,5 million was 31,2% down on the comparative figure for the previous year.

DIVIDENDS

Stakeholders are, no doubt, aware that the full benefits of the restructuring exercise will take some time to be realised. It is therefore of the utmost importance to lay a solid foundation for an agile and flexible organisation capable of rising to the challenges of the new millennium.

Against this background the Board believes it prudent to conserve as much cash as possible and thus recommends that there be no payment of a final dividend for the year ended 30 September 1996.

(2) If a drafting error is not detected before publication, the originating ministry or department is required to draft its own correcting notice, take it to the Attorney-General for vetting and pay for such notice to be published.

- (3) For the removal of doubt—

- (a) a typographical error is made by a typographer;
- (b) a typist's error is classed as a drafting error by reason of the fact that the officer responsible for drafting failed to check the typist's work.

Charges

NOTICES published in the normal columns: \$25 per centimetre or part thereof single column. Taking the depth of such matter, normally spaced, approximately 25 words occupy one centimetre but this can only be a rough guide, as a heading may occupy two centimetres, and certain notices unavoidably contain white space, which must be included in the chargeable depth.

Notices which have to appear in tabular form across the full width of the page, such as lost insurance policies, deceased estates, insolvent estates, company liquidations, notices in terms of the Incolvency Act [Chapter 6:04], changes of companies' names *et cetera*: \$42 per entry.

Copy for all notices to be set in tabular form must be received by 11 a.m. on the Friday preceding the Friday of publication.

Any copy which is received after the respective closing-times will automatically be held over for insertion in the *Gazette* of the following week, in which case no responsibility can be accepted if the purport of the notice is thereby nullified.

When public holidays occur, the normal closing-times are varied, and such variations are notified in the *Gazette* in advance.
