3. All residential flats which are bulk metered 60% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
4. All residential flats with individual meters 450 litres per day.
5. Multi purpose buildings with bulk meter 60% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
6. Hotels, hospitals and clinics 80% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
7. Industrial consumers 75% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
8. Restaurants 75% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005 (NB should the restaurant be a component of multi-purpose building, such restaurant would be required to meter its supplies at own expense).
9. Commercial consumers, schools, churches, institutions, sports clubs, colleges, etc. 60% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
10. Police Stations, Army Barracks and Prisons 60% of average water usage for the six months period ending April, 2005.
11. Esigodini 60% of average water consumption for the six months period ending April, 2005.
12. Mzinyathini Irrigation Scheme 60% of entitlement (for domestic consumption only), for the six months period ending April, 2005.
13. (a) Building operations on 450 litres per day. However there must be evidence of development taking place on the stand.
(b) Extensions and improvements to existing buildings as well as construction of durahalls, etc. These shall be carried out within the normal allocation for the property concerned, i.e. no additional allocation.
(c) Allowances No allowances shall be given for swimming pools, weddings and other gatherings. However, rebates may be considered in the case of funeral gatherings.
14. Underground Water Leaks Underground water leaks will attract the following rebates.
 - (a) First instance: 50% rebate on the penalty but full cost of water which went past the meter.
 - (b) Second instance within three months of the first one: 25% on the penalty but full cost of water which went past the meter.
 - (c) Third instance: there will be no rebate; the penalty will be paid in full.
15. Surcharges Surcharges will be imposed for all excess consumption per kilolitre or part thereof as follows:—
 - (a) Domestic urban—twice the last band rate for Low Density Areas.
 - (b) Domestic peri-urban—twice the last band for this category.
 - (c) Non-domestic-urban—twice the normal rate for this category.
 - (d) Non-domestic-peri-urban—twice the normal rate for this category.
16. If a consumer exceeds the allocation on three consecutive times, the surcharge will be doubled.
17. Consumers are required to monitor their daily consumption of water by reading their water meters daily. This will help deter any unnecessary loss of water.

Only Council-installed or Council-approved meters are permitted.

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of the Water-Rationing Scheme shall be guilty of an offence.

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting *any* kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of copy published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained, elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance 7, 7b, 8, *et cetera*.

10. If a typographical error occurs in the *Gazette*, it is rectified as soon as possible by a correcting notice without charge to the ministry or department concerned, subject to the following conditions—

- (a) that such error is reported to the editor within three months from the date of publication; and
- (b) that the relevant copy, upon re-examination, is proved to be abundantly clear; and
- (c) that the correction of such error is legally necessary.

(2) If a drafting error is not detected before publication, the originating ministry or department is required to draft its own correcting notice, take it to the Attorney-General for vetting and pay for such notice to be published.

(3) For the removal of doubt—

- (a) a typographical error is made by a typographer;
- (b) a typist's error is classed as a drafting error by reason of the fact that the officer responsible for drafting failed to check the typist's work.
