SCHEDULE

Title

1. This order may be cited as Clemency Order No. 1 of 2005.

Remission of sentence for women convicted of infanticide, termination of pregnancy, concealment of birth, and abandonment or exposure of a child

2. A remission of the remainder of the period of imprisonment is hereby granted to those female prisoners of any of the titled offences and sentenced to determinate sentence on or before 30th April, 2005.

Remission of sentences of female prisoners serving life sentences

3. A full remission of sentences of imprisonment is hereby granted to those female prisoners sentenced to serve life sentences and who had served at least live years of their term of imprisonment on or before 30th April, 2005. 4 4.

Remission of sentence for prisoners sentenced to 24 months and below

4. A full remission of sentence is hereby granted to those prisoners sentenced to a ferm of imprisonment of 24 months or under and who on or before 30th April, 2005 had served at least one quarter of their effective term.

Remission of sentence for all prisoners at the open prison

5. A full remission of sentence is hereby granted to all prisoners at the open prison who were not convicted and sentenced for committing a specified offence.

Prisoners excluded from the proposed amnesty

- 6. The following persons are excluded from this amnesty-
- any habitual criminals serving a term of extended imprisonment:
- (b) any person under sentence of death;
- (c) any person serving a sentence imposed by a court martial;
- any person who escaped from lawful custody on or before 30th April, 2005;
- any person serving a sentence for a specified offence other than a prisoner referred to in paragraph 3;
- any person on bail pending appeal against conviction or
- any person serving a sentence for contravening Part II or Part III of the Public Order and Security Act [Chapter 11:17];

- any person serving a sentence for contravening section 36(1 of the Immigration Act [Chapter 4:02];
- · (j) any person serving a sentence for a conviction under the Sexual Offences Act [Chapter 9:21], the Prevention of Corruption Act [Chapter 9:16], the Official Secrets Act [Chapter 11:09], the Exchange Control Act [Chapter 22:05], the Gold Trade Act [Chapter 21:03] or the Precious Stones Act [Chapter 21:06];
- (k) any person serving a sentence imposed by any authority other than a Magistrate or High Court Judge.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Amnesty

"specified offence" means-

- (a) murder, sabotage, treason;
- (b) theft of motor vehicle including car jacking, receiving stolen property (being a motor vehicle), rape, stock theft, housebreaking and theft, robbery and armed robbery. possession of arms of war, fraud, bribery, extortion, forgery and uttering;
- cultivation or possession of dagga for commercial purposes. or manufacture and importation of dagga;
- manufacture or importation of or dealing in or possession of cocaine, mandrax, LSD or any other harmful drugs;
- any conspiracy, incitement or attempt to commit any of the offences referred to in subparagraphs (a), (b), (c) or (d) above;
- being an accessory after the fact to any offence referred to in subparagraphs (a), (b), (c) or (d).
