# COMPETITION ACT [CHAPTER 14:28]

Notice of Proposed Order in terms of Section 31(5) of the Competition Act [Chapter 14:28]

IT is hereby notified, in terms of section 31(5) of the Competition Act [Chapter 14:28], that the Competition and Tariff Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission") conducted a full scale investigation, in terms of section 28 as read with section 33(5) of the Competition Act [Chapter 14:28] (the Act) into the compliance of Total Zimbabwe with the conditions imposed by the Commission on the approval of the Total Zimbabwe/Mobil Oil merger on 26th January, 2006.

Section 31(5) of the Act provides that, before making an order under section 31, the Commission shall ensure that every person affected thereby is informed of the broad terms of the order it proposes to make and is given an adequeate apportunity to make representations in the matter.

The Commission at its 41st Ordinary Meeting held on 22nd October, 2010, considered Total Zimbabwe's submissions, and those of the stakeholders and resolved to make an order in terms of section 31(2)(e) of the Act whose broad terms are as follows:

- That the service stations to be disposed of by Total Zimbabwe to interested indigenous entrepreneurs should be those that became excess as a result of the merger in that the merged party ended up having more than one service station along the same road or street, or in the same area, within a distance of 500 metres between the stations.
- That the fuel depots to be disposed of by Total Zimbabwe to interested indigenous entrepreneurs should be those that became excess as a result of the merger in that the merged party ended up having more than one depot in the same town or province.
- That the lists of the service stations and fuel depots to be disposed of should be approved by the Commission before being offered to interested indingenous entrepreneurs in advertisements in national newspapers.
- 4. That Total Zimbabwe and the interested indigenous entrepreneurs engage independent evaluators that are mutually agreed between them to evaluate the service stations and fuel depots to be disposed of.
- That the merged entity should honour all agreements that Mobil
  Oil Zimbabwe had with other industry players on the use of
  Mobil Oil Zimbabwe's assets for their operations, including

hospitality arrangements, supply arrangements, contract arrangements and dealership arrangements to ensure the maintenance of competition in the relevant market.

The Commission is therefore, before making the above proposed order, calling upon all interested persons or parties to submit written representations if any, in terms of section 31(5) of the Act at the Commission's offices at Second Floor, Block One, No. 1, Kwame Nkrumah Avenue (Private Bag 7774, Causeway), Harare, by Friday, 11th February, 2011, at 9.00 a.m.
