During the past few months or so there have been many cases where *urgent* copy for subsidiary legislation, which requires the signature of the President or a minister to give it effect, and which is of national importance, has been sent in for publication in the

Gazette after closing-time. Whilst I acknowledge that it is the duty of Printflow (Private) Limited to give certain notices special treatment, I am, however, of the view that a *Gazette Extraordinary* has tended to be a must rather than a matter of priority in respect of unwarranted delays of *urgent* copy.

While every effort will continue to be made to publish *Extraordinaries* on the required dates, copy *must* be submitted timeously so that it can be programmed into the printing-work-flow as soon as it is available.
