- 13. The property shall be at the risk and profit of the purchaser from the date upon which the Sheriff confirms the sale and the Sheriff gives no warranty of vacant possession.
- 14. The highest bidder may not withdraw his bid in terms of these conditions of sale prior to the date of confirmation of the sale or rejection of his offer by the Sheriff.

NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL FOR THE MEDICAL AND ALLIED INDUSTRY

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT: MEDICAL AND ALLIED INDUSTRY

Made and entered into in accordance with the provisions of the Labour Act [Chapter 28:01], between the Medical and Allied Employers Association of Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as the "employef" or "the employers organisations"), of the one part, and the Medical Professional and Allied Workers Union of Zimbabwe and Medical and Allied Trades Workers Union of Zimbabwe (hereinafter referred to as "the employees" or "the trade union"), of the other part, being parties to the National Employment Council for the Medical and Allied Industry.

Section 10 (Grading, wages and allowances) of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Medical and Allied Industry published in Statutory Instrument 93 of 2019, is amended by the parties as follows:

Wages/salaries

Wages have been increased by seventy percent (70%) with effect from the 1st December, 2019 to 31st of March, 2020, as tabulated below.

A cost of living allowance of 30% of the new basic wage has also been awarded across all levels with effect from 1st December, 2019 to 31st March, 2020, as follows:

An employee, who, at the date of commencement of this agreement, is in receipt of a higher wage or more favourable benefits for his or her particular occupation than the wage prescribed in terms of this agreement and benefits thereof, shall not, by reason of this agreement, suffer any reduction in his or her wage or benefits.

Employers who are already paying above the stipulated grade minimums may consider awarding dollar value increase.

The above are only minimums and employers who are already paying above stipulated minimums or who can pay above the stated minimums may consider giving increments based on capacity.
