Request for Expression of Interest
Non-consulting Services

FOR the design, supply, installation, configuration and implementation of Online Border Management System at all ports of entry, exit and town offices for the Department of Immigration Control.

The Department of Immigration Control is mandated to provide Entry and Exit facilitation, and issuance of various permits to immigrants.

The Ministry of Home Affairs and Cultural Heritage now invites eligible/qualified ICT solution providers/firms to indicate their interests in providing an Integrated Online Border Management System. The main objective of the project is to implement an efficient

and effective Online Border Management System that is compliant with internationally accepted Immigration best practices.

In consideration of the above-mentioned project, the solution provider is expected to:

1. Carry out a business process re-engineering exercise to efficiently and effectively provide service to the public.
2. Design, supply, install and configure hardware and software for the Online Border Management System that is scalable and compliant with internationally accepted immigration best practices.
3. Provide for integration of the system with other external systems e.g. Zimbabwe Republic Police, Civil Registry, Zimbabwe Investments and Development Agency, Interpol, etc.
4. Provide for data migration.
5. Provide technical training on the configuration, systems administration, systems support, integration and systems security.
6. Provide user training on the functions of the supplied system.

Interested firms must provide information showing that they are qualified to provide the system/services (company registration documents, proof of registration with ICT professional bodies, tax clearance certificates, description of similar assignment, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate qualifications, skills, knowledge and experience of the project team).

The shortlisted shall comprise a minimum of three and a maximum of six firms. However, the Ministry of Home Affairs and Cultural Heritage serves the right to change this number. Each short listed/pre-qualified firm will be required to make a demonstration/presentation of its proposed solution.

Only firms shortlisted under this process will be invited to bid under the International Competitive Bidding process for the above-mentioned non-consulting services and will be invited to bid on the basis of a complete Invitation to Bid/Request for Proposal for the assignment.

Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the Public Procurement and

Disposal of Public Assets Act, published on 1st January, 2018, which is available on the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe (PRAZ) website at <http://www.praz.gov.zw>
