# POLITICAL PARTIES (FINANCE) ACT [CHAPTER 2:11]

## Disbursement of Money to Registered Political Parties

It is hereby notified, in terms of section 3(2) of the Political Parties (Finance) Act [Chapter 2:11], that the total amount of moneys payable to political parties in respect of the year beginning 1st January, 2021 and ending on 31st December, 2021, is one hundred million dollars.

The money shall be disbursed to political parties that qualify in terms of section 3(3) of the Act as follows—

- (a) seventy million and thirty thousand dollars (\$70 030 000,00) shall be paid to the Zimbabwe African National Union (Patriotic Front) ZANU (PF) which received 70,03% of the votes cast; and
- (b) twenty-nine million nine hundred and seventy thousand dollars (\$29 970 000,00) shall be paid to the Movement for Democratic Change—ALLIANCE (MDC-A), which received 29,9% of the total votes cast.

Customs and Excise (Electronic Seals, Parts and Accessories)  
(Rebate)(Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 1)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Finance and Economic Development has, in terms of section 235, as read with section 120, of the Customs and Excise Act [Chapter 23:02], made the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Electronic Seals, Parts and Accessories)(Rebate)(Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 1).

2. The Customs and Excise (Electronic Seals, Parts and Accessories) (Rebate) Regulations, 2017, published in Statutory Instrument 58 of 2017, are amended by the repeal of the Schedule and substituted by the following—

“SCHEDULE

3926.90.90	Other articles of plastic and articles of other materials of headings 39.01 to 39.14.
7312.10.00	Stranded wire, ropes and cables.
7312.90.00	Other plated band, slings and the like of iron or steel, not electronically insulated.
7318.15.00	Other screws and bolts, whether or not their nuts or washers.
8504.40.00	Static converters.
8517.62.00	Machines for the reception, conversion and transmission or regeneration of voice, images or other data, including switching and routing apparatus.
8517.69.00	Other apparatus for transmission or reception of voice, images or other data, including apparatus for communication in a wired or wireless network (such as a local or wide area network):

Chartered Accountants (Amendment) By-laws, 2021 (No. 4)

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IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Finance and Economic Development has, in terms of section 20 of the Chartered Accountants Act [Chapter 27:02], approved the following by-laws made by the Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Zimbabwe: —

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Chartered Accountants (Amendment) By-laws, 2021 (No. 4).

2. The Chartered Accountants By-laws, 1997, published in Statutory Instrument 177 of 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal by-laws”), are amended in section 2—

- (a) in the definition of “practising member” by the insertion of after “Zimbabwe” of “and “non-practising member” shall be construed accordingly”;
- (b) by the repeal of the definition of “repealed by-laws”;

3. The principal by-laws are amended in section 4—

- (a) in subsection (4) by the deletion of “within thirty days subsequent to the 31st March preceding the ordinary general meeting” and substitution of at least not less than thirty days before the date of the Annual General Meeting”;
- (b) in subsection (5) by the deletion of “30th of April” and substitution of “the date of the Annual General Meeting”;
- (c) by the repeal of subsection (7) and substitution with—

“(7) After receipt of the Council nominations, in each year and not later than the issue of the notice of the Annual General Meeting the registrar shall notify the members of the Council of the candidates who have been nominated for each election, indicating the area which each such candidate would represent if elected.”.

4. The principal by-laws are amended in section 22(1) by the deletion of the words “and their addresses”.

5. The principal by-laws are amended in section 28(f) by the deletion of “absentee members” and substitution of “non-resident members”.

6. The principal by-laws are amended in section 31 —

- (a) by the deletion of “31st July” wherever it occurs and substitution with “on or before 120 days from the date of billing”;
- (b) by the deletion in subsection (1) (b) of “31st October of the year in which the subscription is due” and substitution with “10 months from the date of billing”;
- (c) by the insertion in subsection (3)(a) after the words “known address” of “and his or her electronic mail”.

7. The principal by-laws are amended in section 32 by the insertion after “*Gazette*” wherever it appears of “and in any widely circulating local newspaper”.

8. The principal by-laws are amended in section 34 by the deletion of “on 31st March” wherever it appears and substitution of “before the date of the renewal of the practising certificate.”.

9. The principal by-laws are amended in section 45 by the deletion of the words “first fifteen months” and substitution of “first three months”.

10. The principal regulations are amended in section 58 by the insertion after words “registered address” of “and his or her electronic mail”.
