Invitation to Tender (Consultants)

PROVISION of consultancy services for the development of an Application Programme Interface (API) for the Public Service Biometric Authentication Programme (PSBAP).

The Public Service Commission wishes to engage consulting services relating to the development of an Application Programme Interface (API) for Public Service Commission Enterprise—Biometric Authentication Programme.

The Public Service Commission now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The short-listing criteria are:

- 1. The Consulting firm must be a registered entity.
- 2. Must be registered with the Procurement Regulatory Authority.
- Minimum of ten years' experience in the business of ICT assessment.
- The Company should have qualified and experienced ICT Auditors.
- 5. Knowledge of ICT Governance.
- 6. An appreciation of Public Service Business Processes.

The following documents should be submitted in support of the information provided:

- 1. Company profile and proof of company registration.
- 2. Curriculum vitae of key personnel.
- 3. Proof of relevant qualifications and experience.
- At least three references of ICT assessment services carried out with different entities.

Terms of Reference of the contractor

The contractor is expected:

- To provide an interface between SSB and Pension Payrolls and the Registrar General's NID system.
- To ensure that the interface that is developed enables the two Payrolls to query Registrar General's NID system to verify the identity of each employee on the payroll using the NID and biometric data, on a monthly basis before each pay-run or as and when required.
- To prepare the project technical proposal and detailed plans for the project.
- To ensure that Zimbabwean institutions or entities that become part of the project and have live data, shall exclusively administer their own live environments. Access to their live data shall be exclusively for their personnel only. Personnel from those entities shall be trained and capacitated to implement any changes to their live environment to achieve the objectives of the project.
- To provide technical assistance to the SSB and Pension Payrolls and the Registrar General's NID system where necessary, to deal with challenges in implementing the project objectives within their live environments.
- · Establish three separate working environments as follows:
 - * The live environment which should continue functioning uninterrupted throughout the project planning and implementation phases.
 - * The development environment to be used for all the development work that may need to be done during project implementation.
 - * The testing and training environment for the testing of all the developments done in the development environment. It will also be used for training the staff of the user departments.

The contractor's access rights shall be limited to the Development environment as well as the Testing and Training environment.

- The Contractor shall develop safe and secure Application Programme Interfaces (APIs) for linking the databases of the different entities (SSB, Pensions Office, RG's Office).
- The Contractor shall transfer skills to the Government teams at all institutions in the project to enable the running and management of the system after the project is completed.

Short-listed Consultants will be invited to submit detailed Technical and Financial proposals, as described in Part 1 of the Request for Proposals Procedures in the Standard Request for Proposals for the Selection of Consultancy Services.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures specified in Part VIII of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act [Chapter 22:23] and Part VI of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (General) Regulations, 2018 (Statutory Instrument 5 of 2018). Short-listed Consultants will be invited to submit their proposals on a separate document based on the Standard Request for Proposals for the Selection of Consultancy Services and the Consultant submitting the successful proposal will be engaged on the contractual terms set out in that document and in the General Conditions of Contract for Consultancy Services. Copies of the Act and Regulations and the standard documentation are available on the website of the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe.

This opportunity is open to all Consultants who meet the criteria for eligibility as stated in section 28 of the Act and who have the nationality of an eligible country as defined in Clause 1.10 of the General Conditions of Contract for Consultancy Services. The Consultant and its sub-consultants must provide personnel who are citizens of eligible countries.

Participation is open to Zimbabwean bidders ONLY.

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Banking (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 7)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Finance and Economic Development has, in terms of section 81 of the Banking Act [Chapter 24:20] and in consultation with the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe as required by subsection (5) of that section, made the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Banking (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 7).
- 2. Section 13 of the Banking (Amendment) Regulations, 2020, (No. 5), published in Statutory Instrument 265 of 2020, is amended in subsection (3) by the repeal of "fifteen thousand United States dollars" and substitution of "an amount, in local currency, equivalent to fifteen thousand United States dollars."
