While every effort will continue to be made to publish Extraordinaries on the required dates, copy must be submitted timeously so that it can be programmed into the printing-work-flow as soon as it is available.

PENSIONS INDUSTRY**

For the period 1st January, 2021 to 31st March, 2021

This agreement is made in terms of the Labour Act [*Chapter 28:07*], between the Insurance Employers Association of Zimbabwe (IEAZ) (“the employers association”), on the one hand, and the Insurance Employees Union of Zimbabwe (ZIEU) (“the trade union”), on the other hand, being parties to the National Employment Council for the Insurance and Pensions Industry (NECPI).

This supplementary agreement is made in terms of the Principal Agreement (Statutory Instrument 146 of 2016).

The details of the agreement are as follows:

1. That with effect from 1st January, 2021, to 31st March, 2021, companies/employers in the Insurance and Pensions Industry effect a 26.08% increase on basic minimum salary for grades A1 to C3 as per table below.
2. That with effect from 1st January, 2021, to 31st March, 2021, companies/employers in the Insurance and Pensions Industry award a minimum housing allowance of \$4 750,00, per month for each NEC graded employee.
3. That with effect from 1st January, 2021, to 31st March, 2021, companies/employers in the Insurance and Pensions Industry award a minimum transport allowance of **\$3 960.00** per month grossed up for tax purposes for each NEC graded employee.

4. That companies/employers who are able to pay more are encouraged to do so and to advise the NEC of such awards.
5. Companies/Employers that are not able to comply with this CBA should apply for exemption to the NECIPI Exemption Committee within a month from the date of this agreement. Such applications should be accompanied by appropriate and relevant financial statements.
6. That companies/employers are reminded to remit NEC levies as required in terms of Statutory Instalment 146 of 2016.

Petroleum (Mandatory Blending of Anhydrous Ethanol with
Unleaded Petrol) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 4)

IT is hereby notified that The Minister of Energy and Power Development has, in terms of section 57 of the Petroleum Act [Chapter 13:22} and after consultation with the Authority, made the following regulations: —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Mandatory Blending of Anhydrous Ethanol with Unleaded Petrol) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 (No. 4).

2. Section 4(1) of the Petroleum (Mandatory Blending of Anhydrous Ethanol with Unleaded Petrol) Regulations, 2013, published in Statutory Instrument 17 of 2013, is repealed and substituted by the following—

“(1) No procurement licensee or wholesale licensee shall sell unleaded petrol, unless the unleaded petrol has been blended with a minimum of ten *per centum* locally produced ethanol, being ethanol blend grade E10, which is produced by a licensed blender:

Provided that the Authority in consultation with the Minister may, by publication of a notice in one or more newspapers which widely circulate in the country and on the Authority’s website, grant an exception from the level of blending in exceptional circumstances.”.

2. This notice shall be deemed to have come into effect on 1st August, 2020.

3. The First Schedule to the Customs and Excise (Tariff) Notice, 2017, published in Statutory Instrument 53 of 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the notice) is amended in Part III by the deletion of Note 1 and substitution with the following—

“1. Clearance under this Part is restricted to goods appearing in column (1) below excluding motor vehicles of commodity code 8702.10.11; 8702.90.11; 8704.21.20; 8704.21.40; 8704.31.20; and 8704.31.40. The duties payable are shown in column (4):

Provided that the above exclusion will not apply to donated operational motor vehicles including single and double cab trucks, donated by Development Partners, as may be approved by the Secretary responsible for the Government Ministry for use in that Ministry”.

4. The notice is amended in Part III by the insertion of the following new item after the last item on donated educational requisites for tertiary institutions —

“3. Donated motor vehicles for government ministries
