Application forms should be obtained from the Registrar, University College of Cape Coast, Cape Coast, with whom completed forms should be lodged not later than *9th June, 1970*. Stamped addressed envelopes should accompany requests for application forms.

Applicants in the Civil Service, Statutory Corporations and the Universities should forward their applications through their heads of departments or registrars. Persons under bond need not apply. Copies of testimonials, etc., attached to application forms are not returnable.
