PHARMACY BOARD—MINISTRY OF HEALTH

NOTICE—PHARMACY BOARD REGISTRATION

It is notified for general information that with immediate effect, every person who possesses a valid Pharmacy Board registration, and who submits a valid licence for renewal shall, in addition to the prescribed conditions, produce a valid Income Tax Clearance Certificate as a compulsory prerequisite for the renewal of such licence.

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE—FISHERIES DIVISION—FISHERY RESEARCH UNIT

VACANCIES FOR LEARNER LABORATORY TECHNICIAN

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to undergo a three-year course of training leading to the appointment as Technical Officer (Laboratory).

The course will be partly undertaken in the laboratory and on board research vessels at sea.

1. *Qualifications.*—Candidates, who must be citizens of Ghana, must—

(a) possess the G.C.E. "O" Level or its equivalent with passes in English and Mathematics, and one or more of the following subjects: General Science, Biology, Physics and Chemistry.

(b) Aptitude for sea-going is essential.

Age limit: Between 16 and 25 years.

2. *Allowances.*—N¢510, N¢540 and N¢570 per annum.

3. Selected candidates will be bonded to complete the course and serve for five years in the Fishery Research Unit.

4. Candidates who successfully complete the course will be eligible for appointment as Technical Officer (Laboratory) on salary ranges 29, 35, 40 (i.e. N¢792-N¢1,428).

Technical Officers have prospects of promotion to the grade of Laboratory Superintendent and thereafter to higher specialized posts in the Unit depending upon aptitude and ability.

GHANA ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION—(NATIONAL CENTRE FOR RADIOISOTOPE APPLICATIONS)
 VACANCIES FOR WORKS SUPERINTENDENT AND STENOGRAPHERS GRADES I AND II

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Ghanaians for the following posts in the National Centre for Radioisotope Applications:

A. WORKS SUPERINTENDENT

Qualifications.—Candidates must possess the Final City and Guilds Certificate or its equivalent in Building (Civil) or Estate Management with at least 5 (five) years' practical experience in a supervisory grade (i.e. Junior Foreman).

Duties.—Inspection, erection, maintenance and repairs of buildings, furniture and roads; keeping of inventory and ledgers in respect of furniture and materials; supervision of labour and preparation of estimates.

B. STENOGRAPHER GRADE I

Qualifications.—Candidates must:

- (i) possess a good general education and must have passed the Qualifying English Examinations of the West African Examinations Council or the English Examinations of the West African School Certificate or equivalent qualification;
- (ii) be able to write shorthand at the rate of 100 words per minute for 3 minutes and type at the rate of 40 words per minute for 10 minutes, and have had not less than 3 years' experience as Stenographer Grade I.

C. STENOGRAPHER GRADE II

Qualifications.—Candidates must possess Middle School Leaving Certificate and a good general education and must be able to write shorthand at the rate of 80 words per minute for 10 minutes.

Duties.—General typing and secretarial duties.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Ghanaians for appointment to the vacant posts of Principal and Vice-Principal, Government Training College, Tamale.

PRINCIPAL

Qualifications.—Graduates of recognised Universities with at least 7 years' postgraduate teaching experience. Provided that graduate certificated teachers with 5 years' or more pre-graduation teaching experience, must have taught for 5 years after graduation. Those with 3 years but less than 5 years' pre-graduation teaching experience must have taught for 6 years after graduation, and those with less than 3 years' pre-graduation teaching experience and all others must have taught for the whole 7-year period after graduation.

VICE-PRINCIPAL

Graduates of recognised Universities with at least 5 years' postgraduate teaching experience or graduate certificated teachers with at least 5 years' pre-graduation teaching experience plus at least 3 years' postgraduation teaching experience.

The successful candidate will be required to head the Department of Industrial Art.

Qualifications.—Candidates must possess A.R.C.A., Dip.A.D., B.A. or equivalent, and must have extensive experience in teaching, research and/or industry and be capable administrators, able to initiate and supervise practical research.

Salary (Under Review):

Professor.—N¢6,400 per annum (Consolidated)

Associate Professor.—N¢6,000 per annum (Consolidated)

(plus non-taxable Inducement Allowance of N¢900 per annum payable to expatriates).

In appropriate cases, a supplementation allowance in range £952–£1,124 per annum will be paid in sterling by the U.K. Ministry of Overseas Development which also provides Children's Education Allowances and holiday passages in addition to similar facilities granted by the University.
