GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP IN PHYSIOTHERAPY

It is proposed to award a number of scholarships for a three-year course of training tenable in the United Kingdom leading to Membership of the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy. The award is to enable selected candidates to qualify for appointment as Physiotherapist on the Salary Range 45, 50, i.e. (€1,488-€2,124 per annum) in the Ministry of Health.

2. Candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana on successful completion of their studies and serve in Government Service or as otherwise directed.

3. *Qualifications:*

(a) Candidates must be citizens of Ghana.

(b) They must hold the following educational qualifications or their equivalent:—

(i) A Grade I or II West African School Certificate or its equivalent with "Credit" in English Language, Mathematics and three other subjects, one of which must be Science; or

(ii) The General Certificate of Education obtained at not more than two examinations at Ordinary Level in English Language, Mathematics and three other subjects, one of which must be Science.

(c) Preference will be given to Staff Nurses (S.R.N.).
