NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT OF REGIONAL HOUSES OF CHIEFS AND FIVE (5) REPRESENTATIVES TO THE NATIONAL HOUSE OF CHIEFS

The Registrars of the Western, Central, Volta, Gt. Accra, Eastern, Brong Ahafo, Northern, Ashanti, Upper East and Upper West Regional Houses of Chiefs have notified the Electoral Commission that vacancies have occurred in the offices of the President and the Vice-President of the Houses and of the five (5) representatives of the Houses to the National House of Chiefs.

(2) In accordance with sections 1 (2), 6 (6) and 7 of the chieftaincy Act 1971 (ACT 370) and in consultation with the Registrars of the Regional Houses of Chiefs, the Chairman of the Electoral Commission has decided that meetings of the Houses should be convened at their respective meeting halls for the purpose of holding the elections as follows—

(3) The purpose of this letter is to summon members to the meeting to record their votes.

(4) Nominations for the elections are to be delivered to the respective Regional Directors of the Electoral Commission or at the offices of the Regional Houses of Chiefs between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 12 noon and 2.00 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. as follows—

(5) Each candidate is to be nominated on a separate nomination form and every nomination should be subscribed by the signatures or marks of two (2) members of the respective Regional House of Chiefs as proposer and seconder and assented to by another member of the respective House, and endorsed with the consent of the nominee.

(6) With respect to the five (5) members as Representatives to the National House of Chiefs, each member for the respective Regional House of Chiefs is entitled to nominate, second or assent to the nomination of not more than five (5) candidates.

(7) The Representatives of the respective Regional Houses of Chiefs to the National House of Chiefs should be of the status of Paramount Chiefs from the respective regions unless there are less than five (5) Paramount Chiefs in a particular region in which case the Regional House shall elect Divisional Chiefs to make up the required number of Representatives from the Region.

(8) Attached hereto are two (2) sets of nomination forms for appropriate use. Copies of the nomination forms may also be obtained from the respective Regional Directors of the Electoral Commission.

(9) The procedure for the election will be as laid down in Rules 5-14 of the Chieftaincy (National House of Chiefs) Election Rules 1970 (LI 746).
