1. To report all crimes in his district and to help Government to obtain witnesses for trials.
2. To assist in Hut Tax collecting.
3. To report all contagious diseases both of persons and stock.
4. To report any removal of or addition to the number of native houses in his area.
5. To keep the villages and surroundings in a clean condition, including public roads between villages.
6. To prevent pollution of streams.
7. To prevent forest fires, and to report any to the nearest Forest Officer or Government Official.
8. To prevent grass fires from escaping from native areas.
9. To encourage and advise his people to work for the current rate of wages.
10. Any other duties which he may be called upon to perform by a Government Official with sanction of the Governor.
