THE MAINTENANCE OLDERS ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE

PROCLAMATION

J W BARTH



BY His Excellency Sii Jacob William Baith, Knight, Commander of the Mort Excellent Order of the British Empire, Acting Governor and Commander in Chief of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya

WHEREAS by section 10 of the Maintenance Orders Enforcement Ordinance (Chapter 169 of the Revised Edition) it is enacted that where the Governor is satisfied that

recipiocal provisions have been made by the legislature of any British Possession or any Territory under His Majesty's protection for the enforcement within such Possession or Territory of maintenance orders made by the courts in the Colony. The Governor may by proclamation extend this Ordinance to maintenance orders made by the courts within such Possession or Territory, and chereupon this Ordinance shall apply to such maintenance orders as if they had been made in England or Ireland

And whereas I am satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislature of the Territory for the Seat of Government of the Commonwealth of Australia for the enforcement within that Territory of maintenance orders made by the courts of the Colony

Now therefore, by the powers in me vested as aforesaid, I do hereby proclaim and declare that the provisions of the said Ordinance are extended to maintenance orders made by a court having jurisdiction in the Territory for the Seat of Government of the Commonwealth of Australia
